GRAPHIC DESIGN is the process of visual communication and problem-solving through the use of typography, photography, iconography and illustration.

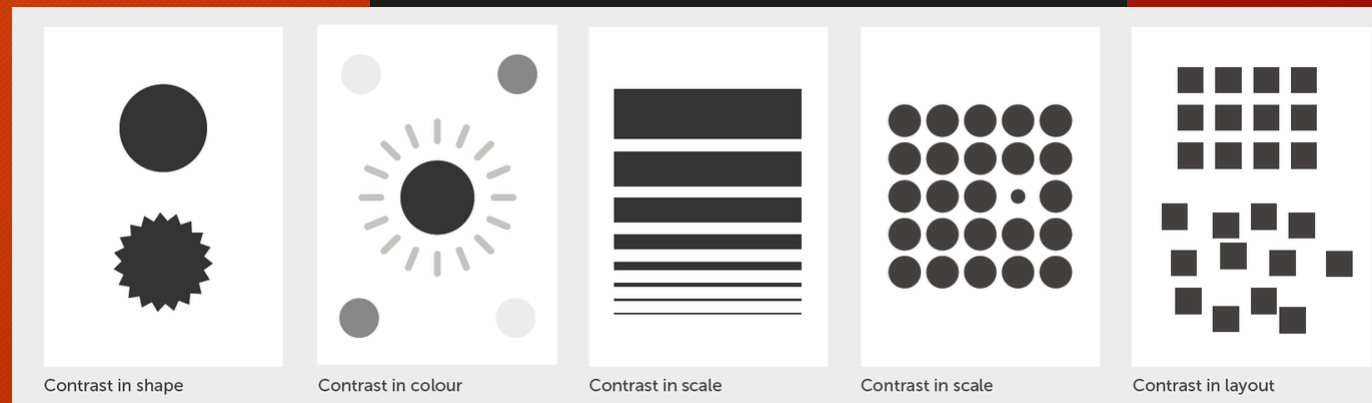
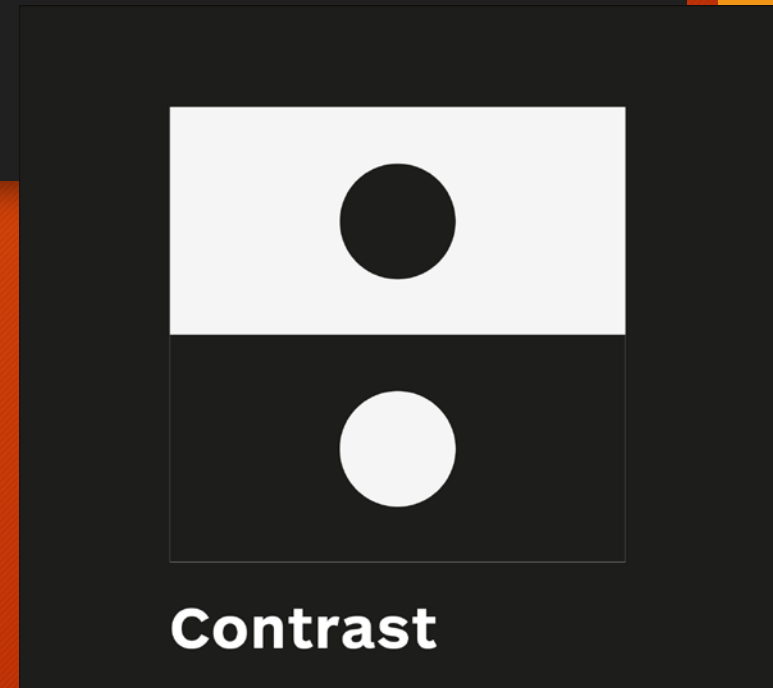

Contrast, Hierarchy, Balance, Scale & Proportion, Emphasis, Movement & Rhythm, Pattern, Unity

Contrast/Readability

- Contrast can be defined as a difference between two or more elements in a composition. The more difference between the elements, the easier they are to compare and comprehend.

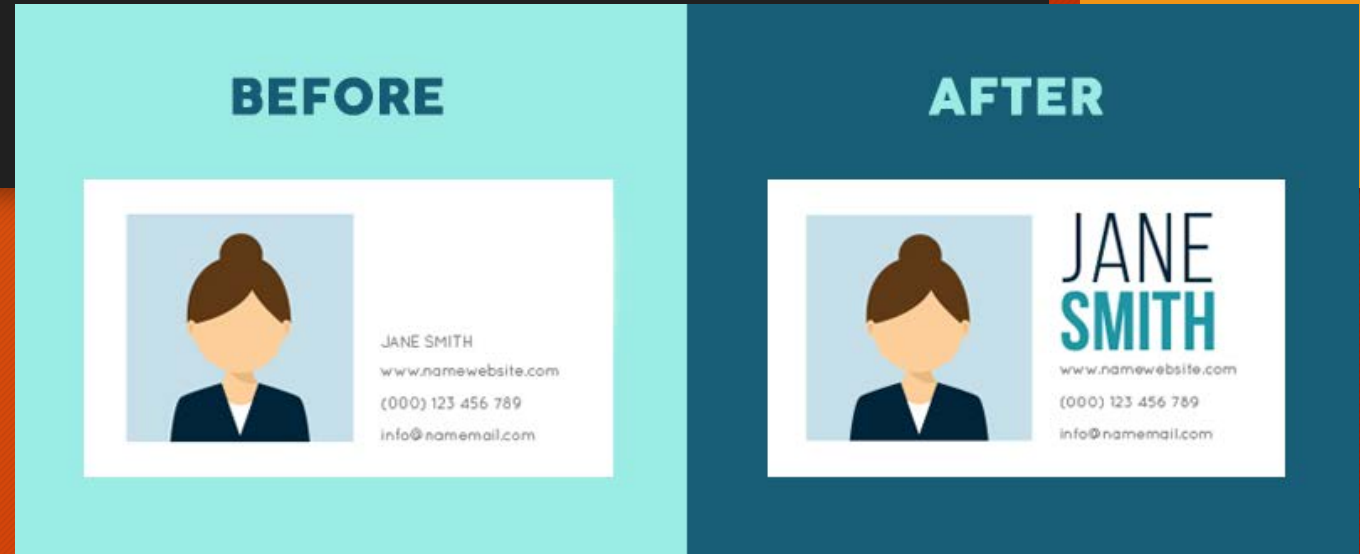

Hierarchy

- Hierarchy is the control of visual information in an arrangement or presentation to imply importance. Hierarchy influences the order in which the human eye perceives what it sees

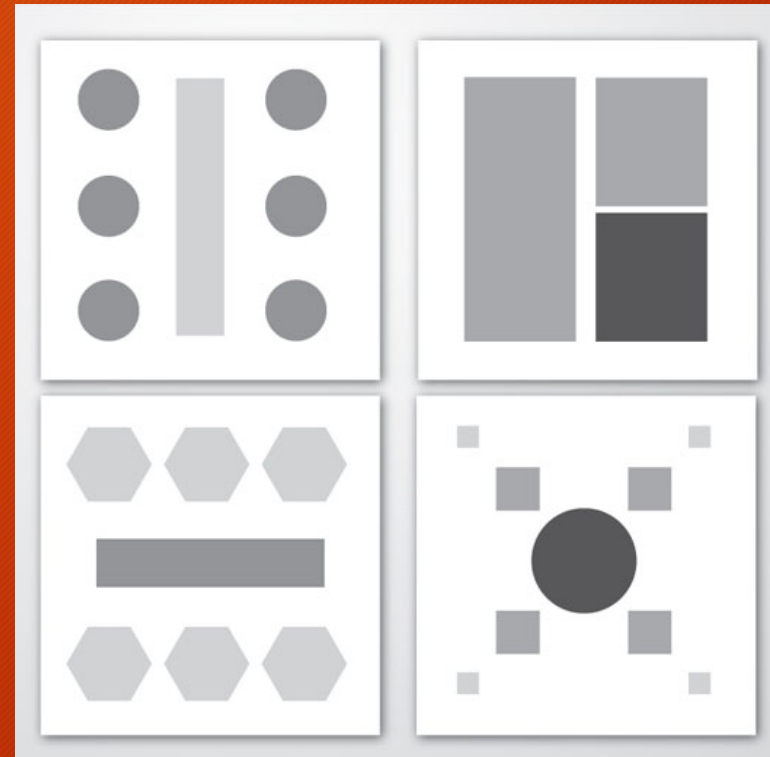

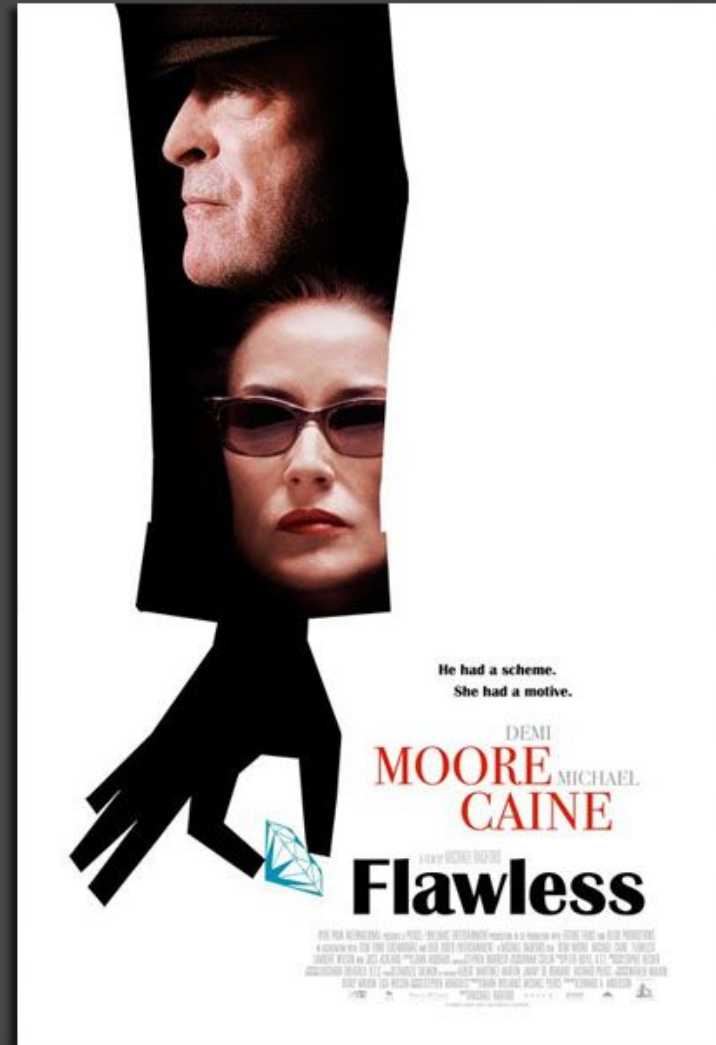
Balance

- Balance is the distribution of the visual weight of objects, colors, texture, and space.





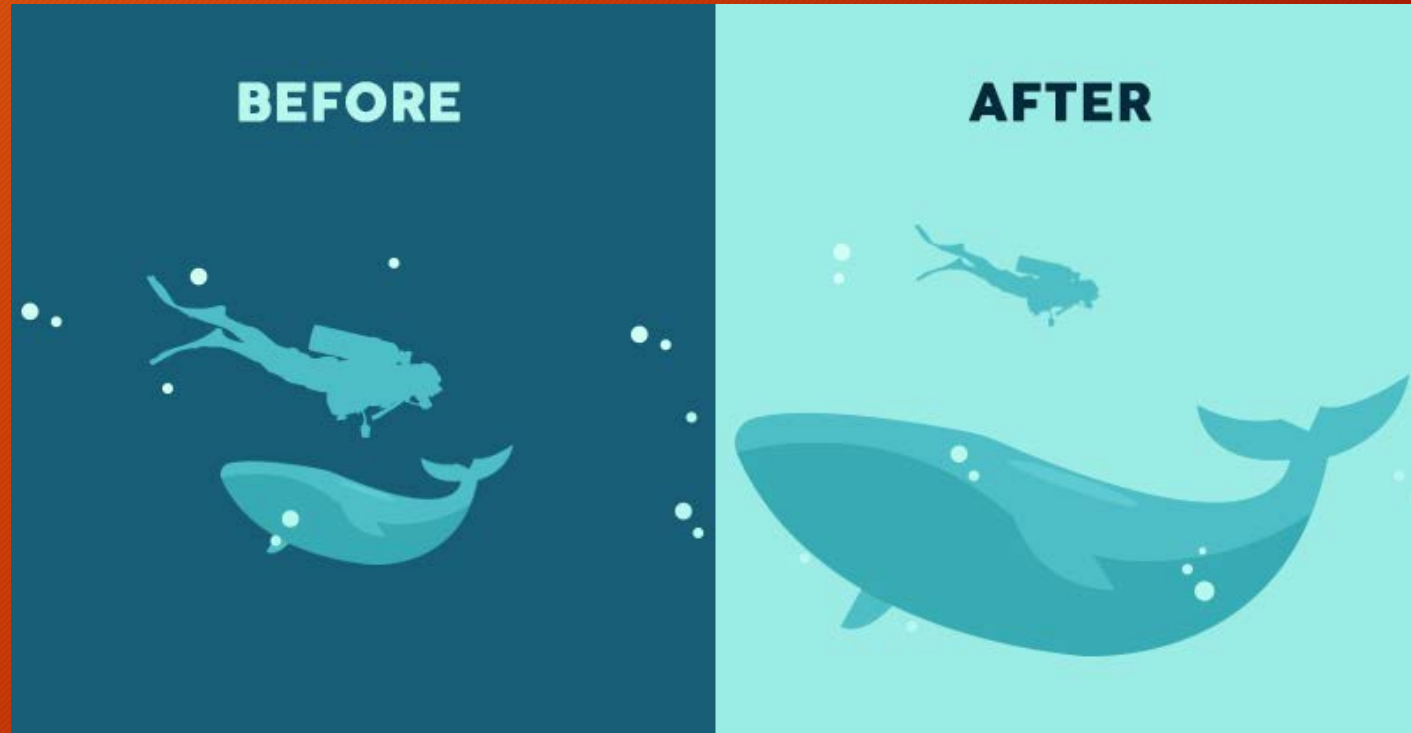
Symmetrical Balance

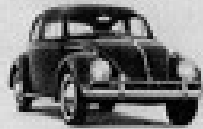


Asymmetrical Balance

Scale & Proportion

- *Scale* refers to the relative size of a *design* element in comparison to another element.

(Balance, Scale, Proportion)

Tips

- Define your Goals
- Know your Target Audience
- Schedule posts in advance
- Find out what's Trending
- Use #hashtags
- Be Consistent
- Use images with your posts to grab attention
- Plan your content
- Use programs like Hootsuite, Buffer, etc.
- Analyze your posts results
- Interact with your audience (ask questions, reply, call for action)
- Giveaways! Have your audience, like, share and comment to be entered into a prize. Everyone likes free stuff.
- Link Social Media together (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, Youtube)
