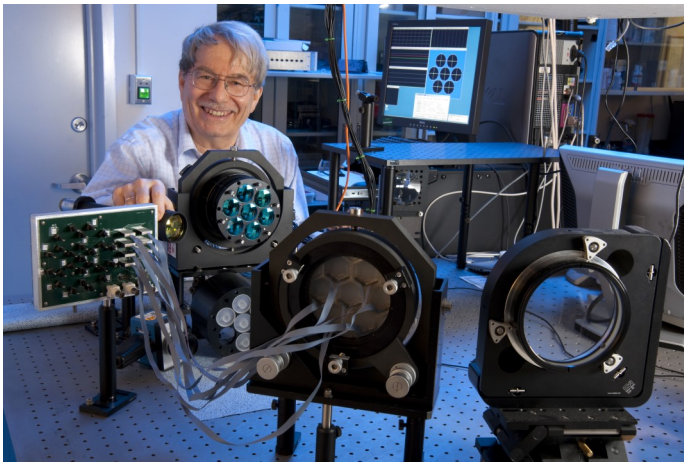


# Department of Defense 2020 Faculty Fellows Research Team Program



## Spend ten weeks working with Department of Defense scientists and engineers in state-of-the-art research facilities



AIHEC is inviting STEM faculty-student research teams to participate in a 10-week summer research program sponsored by the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Research and Engineering (OUSD(R&E)).

A faculty-student research team consists of one faculty member and one student from the same institution. Research teams work alongside DOD research laboratory scientists and engineers, providing a unique professional development and learning opportunity for faculty members and students that can provide a pathway to exciting career possibilities for students and sustained partnerships with DOD researchers for faculty. - One-on-one research interest and skills matching
- Three day pre-program visit which includes round trip transportation and lodging
- Roundtrip transportation to research location for program
- Summer housing supplement and a research stipend
- Post-fellowship—opportunity to continue research activities at your home institution

### You're eligible if you:

- Have a STEM faculty appointment at a TCU
- Are a U.S. citizen
- Commit to full-time participation at a research site for 10 weeks
- Recruit a motivated TCU student to your team
