History of NACDEP

The momentum for the creation of NACDEP began at the National Community Resource and Economic Development (CRED) Conference that was held in Orlando, Florida in 2002. NACDEP was officially organized in 2005 and currently has over 400 members. Two national association meetings have been held. The 2005 conference was held in Las Vegas, Nevada and the 2006 national meeting was conducted in San Antonio, Texas.

Objectives

NACDEP promotes:

- cooperation on community development issues between the states and regions, as well as between governmental agencies and private community development groups.
- educational and training programs and activities that advance sound community development practices.
- expanded investments in applied social science research to support high priority Extension community development education programs.
- 1862, 1890 and 1994 land grant system objectives.
